

TABLET AND PEN KIT (WACOM)

WHAT YOU NEED

A laptop or computer with a USB port

DEVICE COMPATIBILITY DETAILS

List of compatible devices can be found on the official Wacom website.



HOW TO SET UP

- 1. Plug the USB cable into the wacom tablet (you will find the socket located on the side)
- 2. Plug the other end of the USB cable into your laptop or computer (this will trigger your computer/laptop to set up the device/driver)
- 3. Once the device is ready you should be able to use (each subsequent time you plug it in, you should not have to go through the same set up process)

Caution:

Gently press/draw with the pen on the tablet (you should not have to use force for the pen to work)

HOW TO USE

- Hovering the pen over the board will move your mouse around the screen.
- Pressing (gently) down on the tablet will draw/write (if you have an appropriate application open)
- Different applications may use the tablet and pen triggers differently, but generally taping the tablet or using the bottom button is the same as left click of your mouse, the top button is similar to the right click of your mouse.
- The cursor should follow your movements on the screen (if you find the directions are incorrect or mirrored, rotate the placement of the tablet to adjust)

For first time users:

Open up a generic word/text document or paint application once connected and have a play with the controls (it will take a bit of time to get used to it before it feels natural).
